Mental Health Core School- AHS/GPPSD – dedicated professional to come into the school once a month to support students and teachers with a variety of Social Emotional Learning and delivering age-appropriate teaching to classes.

- Frontier College- offering reading program support to students in grade k-6 (starts in October)
- Elder Darlene Cardinal- is joining us again at Avondale. She will be in the building on Monday afternoons and will be working with all the classes. (Seven Sacred teachings, Treaty 8, respect, and acceptance)
- The Nutrition Program is up and running again. There is a need in our community. Please share this information with any school community members that may need support or would benefit from the program.
- Traffic Plan update- so far it seems to be running smoother, less traffic in the front loop,
