6. Board Member Report – Lesley Craig
 - Christmas card contest – There were around 200 entries. A Grade 6 student from Ecole Montrose was the winner. 2nd place went to a Grade 5 student from Riverstone. 3rd place was awarded to a Grade 5 student from Isabel Campbell. The 1st prize winner has their artwork become the cover of the District Christmas card the year and wins \$100.
 - Prime Minister's Award for teachers – This award honours exemplary teachers and early childhood educators who are preparing youth for a digital and innovation-based economy. Nominations are due January 14, 2019.

- New Initiatives from the Board
 - Online registrations for new students will be starting next school year. This will save admin and their assistants time.
 - Meetings will take place directly between trustees and high school students to gather their feedback and info. The first one will be with Charles Spencer at Dec. 13th over the lunch hour. Meetings with students at The Comp and The Bridge will take place in the new year.
 - There will be a donation from the Board of \$200 to each school to help with planned Christmas activities.
 - Classroom Supervisors – Due to a shortage of substitute teachers, we are implementing a procedure to be able to use non-certificated staff to supervise in our classrooms when a sub cannot be found.
 - There has been an approved change to AP260 regarding the requirement for students to have all recommended vaccinations before travelling on international field trips (this applies mostly to high school students).

a) Munch a Lunch

- a. Kristina will find out how much the yearly membership is and will report back. The cost of the Munch-a-Lunch is \$300 for the year. We have made \$104.50 profit with three lunches.
