- 5. School Board Report Trustee Ray Buziak
  - a. Ray attended the graduations for the Comp, Charles Spencer, and The Bridge Network. Over 500 students graduated from GPPSD schools this year. The graduation rate was approximately 90 percent this year.

  - a. Status of the School Council accounts:

      - There were only five parents at the meeting who could vote. Anna suggested we table this vote to the fall, when we will hopefully have more parents present to vote.
