Reporting and Scheduling a Student Absence

SchoolMessenger

Beginning September 2024 the Grande Prairie Public School Division is now using SchoolMessenger to improve communication with parents and guardians.

To simplify reporting and responding to student absences we are using [SchoolMessenger](#)'s reporting system called SafeArrival.

Reporting student absences can be done in three ways, choose the most convenient for you: mobile app, email or phone call.

If your student is marked absent and the absence hasn't been reported in SchoolMessenger, SafeArrival will contact parents/guardians by automated phone call, text message, email or mobile app push notification (depending on how you have set your preferences in SchoolMessenger- Attendance) for you to indicate a reason for the absence.

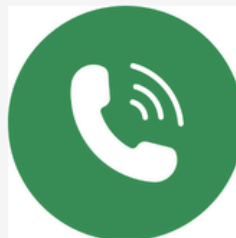

Drop Off & Pick Up Doors

- To help us manage students arriving in the morning and leaving after school, students are to use the exterior doors designated as their entrance where their boot racks are located.
- In the morning and afterschool, Parent/guardians are asked to pick up or drop off their child at the designated exterior door.

- If students need to leave school during the day, please make sure you have come into the office, through the main doors to sign them out.

- All visitors, including parents/guardians, are required to check in at the office upon entering the school; therefore, we ask parents and guardians to only use the main doors enter or exit the building.

Orange Shirt Day - Sept. 27

Across Canada, National Day for Truth and Reconciliation (NDTR) is officially recognized on September 30th each year. As part of our commitment to Reconciliation, our school division is hosting an Orange Shirt Day on Friday, September 27, giving students and staff an opportunity to honour Survivors together.

History of Orange Shirt Day

Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission Residential School (1891-1981) Commemoration Project and Reunion events that took place in Williams Lake, BC, Canada, in May 2013. Today, Orange Shirt Day events continue to commemorate the residential school experience, witness and honour the healing journey of the Survivors and their families, and commit to the ongoing process of Reconciliation. Survivors' Flag

In the act of Reconciliation, we are sharing information from the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation's exhibit: The Survivors' Flag. The flag is an expression of remembrance, meant to honour residential school Survivors and all the lives and communities impacted by the residential school system in Canada. 
