

SchoolMessenger is limited to legal parents or guardians and delivers emails, text messages and phone calls directly to your email and phone number associated with your PowerSchool account. Once your account is created, set your preferences for general communication,

Reporting and Scheduling a Student Absence


SchoolMessenger

Beginning September 2024 the Grande Prairie Public School Division is now using SchoolMessenger to improve communication with parents and guardians.

To simplify reporting and responding to student absences we are using <u>SchoolMessenger's</u> reporting system called SafeArrival.

Reporting student absences can be done in three ways, choose the most convenient for you: mobile app, email or phone call.

If your student is marked absent and the absence hasn't been reported in SchoolMessenger, SafeArrival will contact parents/guardians by automated phone call, text message, email or mobile app push notification (depending on how you have set your preferences in SchoolMessenger-Attendance) for you to indicate a reason for the absence.

Drop Off & Pick Up Doors

- In the morning and afterschool, Parent/guardians are asked to pick up or drop off their child at the designated exterior door.



What is KinderPAL?

Our school is proud to provide KinderPAL Play and Learn experience as a Program of Choice for our families of Kindergarten-aged children.

Children experience full school day learning with Kindergarten programming for half their time, and the other half is KinderPAL. A certified teacher provides provincial Kindergarten curriculum instruction, and a KinderPAL instructor provides KinderPAL programming.

Orange Shirt Day - Sept. 27

Across Canada, National Day for Truth and Reconciliation (NDTR) is officially recognized on September 30th each year. As part of our commitment to Reconciliation, our school division is hosting an Orange Shirt Day on Friday, September 27, giving students and staff an opportunity to honour Survivors together.

History of Orange Shirt Day

Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission Residential School (1891-1981) Commemoration Project and Reunion events that took place in Williams Lake, BC, Canada, in May 2013. Today, Orange Shirt Day events continue to commemorate the residential school experience, witness and honour the healing journey of the Survivors and their families, and commit to the ongoing process of Reconciliation. The first 100 people to register at the event will receive a medal!! **




